**Dear neighbour,**

**Plans to develop a Waste Transfer Station at our Long Leys Road site**

We promised to keep you informed about our plans. I can now confirm that we will be appealing the decision to refuse permission for our proposed development of Veolia's Long Leys Road site.

**Why Long Leys Road?**

We have been operating successfully on this site for many years and hold a long term lease for the site. We are firmly of the view that expanding our operations here to create a waste transfer station is an appropriate course of action for our business and for those businesses we serve.

**What does that mean for the local community?**

As an established employer in Lincoln with 42 employees locally, we already contribute to jobs and to the local economy and enhancing our activities will mean we can also manage locally produced waste more efficiently too.

**What impact will this have locally?**

An existing building on the site will be replaced with a larger building that accommodates all the activity. In partnership with the landowner we will look to maintain and enhance the planting along the site boundaries.

We have heard concerns about noise and vehicles twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

To be clear, the waste transfer station will not operate at night. Our planning application set out the proposed hours of operation which are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 5pm on Saturday.

Currently there are a number of vehicles using Long Leys Road and accessing local businesses. Our proposals include plans to improve access to the site for us and for our neighbours, which will benefit those that live and work in the area.
