# Minutes of Long Leys Residents' Association (LLRA) Annual General Meeting (AGM) 7pm Tuesday 22 May, Discovery Café, St George's

## 1. Opening Remarks from Chair

	Action
The Chair welcomed residents and guests to the 2018 AGM. The victory over Veolia was mentioned as the LLRA (& StopVeolia) highlight of the last 12 months.	
A vote of thanks was given to former resident and recently-retired local city councillor Tony Speakman for his assistance to the community over the years.	

### 2. Minutes of 2017 AGM

Were accepted as a true record of the meeting. Matters arising will be reviewed in the residents meeting following the 2018 AGM.

# 3. Proposals Agreed by Residents

The following proposals were debated by the meeting and then voted on. Decisions were unopposed except where noted.

- a) A new constitution was approved.

- b) It was agreed that the LLRA should lead the development of a Neighbourhood Plan for Long Leys.
- c) It was agreed in principle that circa £3,000 of Section 106 money should be spent on the purchase of a SID (Speed Indicator Device) from Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership.
   A show of hands gave 29 for the proposal, 22 against with 12 abstaining.
- d) The StopVeolia legal fund will cease, with future responsibility for managing the community money handed over to LLRA.

Note: The meeting was advised that £500 from the fund would be released for LLRA operational expenses with the remainder being held in an interest-bearing account as a legal defence fund until June 2019 at the earliest. When the threat from Veolia is judged to be remote a decision will be made on releasing some or all of the funds for community purposes in Long Leys and the wider Carholme Community.

A vote of thanks was given to the three legal fund trustees, Richard Dale, Councillor Robert Parker and Gary Stimson who, as well as acting as trustees, had all played a key role in the campaign.

#### 4. 2017/2018 LLRA Accounts

The total LLRA balance at bank including the legal fund was £12,226.01.

A request was made for a local resident with financial skills to examine the 2017/2018 accounts. This offer was not taken up.

## 5. LLRA Management Committee Elections

Alex Rosen, Tony Wass and Emma Olivier-Townrow stood down as committee members in line with the previous constitution. Tony Wass, Emma Olivier-Townrow along with Jackie Ward, co-opted treasurer, indicated they would be standing for election.

A vote of thanks was given to outgoing committee member Alex Rosen for his help over the last year, not least for his extensive efforts on the StopVeolia campaign.

An invitation was made by the chair for other residents to put themselves forward for election to the LLRA committee. This offer was not taken up.

In line with the new constitution, Tony Wass, Emma Olivier-Townrow and Jackie Ward were elected by the meeting for a 3-year term as LLRA management committee members.

The LLRA management committee 2018/2019: Gary Stimson (Chair), Megan Cox (Vice-Chair), Jackie Ward (Treasurer), Jon Davies (Secretary), Keith Newsome, Tony Wass, Chris Taylor, Emma Olivier-Townrow (Commons Advisory Panel representative).
