

HOW TO BOOK YOUR JOURNEY...

1. Call or go online

Now you're registered simply call or go online to book your journey. Quote your unique registration number; request the day and time of the journey you require including amount of passengers, pick up location and destination.

Useful! Don't forget to mention when you book if you have a connection or onward travel arranged.

2. We will confirm your journey times

If we are not able to offer you the exact times you need, we will suggest the nearest available.

3. Arrive on time for your bus

Please be ready a few minutes before your pick up time. To help our drivers keep to schedule we ask all passengers to be waiting at the booked pick up point.

Remember: Our flexible buses run to a 10 minute pick up window after your confirmed time. You can track your bus on its way to you up to an hour before you travel.

4. Get on the CallConnect bus

Pay your fare (or show your saver ticket or concessionary bus pass) and enjoy the journey!

It helps to remember: We are able to accommodate the majority of booking requests; however, the more notice you give the better. Bookings can be taken from 1 hour up to 7 days in advance of the journey time requested.

WHERE CAN I GO?

Our West Lindsey area CallConnect bus services are designed to enable passengers to travel to local towns, villages and transport hubs.

CallConnect complements the wider transport network, helping you make connections to travel further. Whether you need to travel for work, study, leisure or appointments, get on board with CallConnect.

Bus connections

CallConnect will connect you to timetabled bus services within the West Lindsey area.

Connection points include: Gainsborough, Market Rasen, Caistor, Saxilby and Lincoln Waitrose Park and Ride.

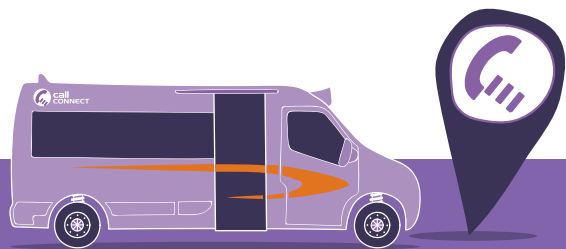


CONNECTING LINCOLNSHIRE

Since 2001 CallConnect's fleet of buses have served the public of Lincolnshire enabling passengers to connect and travel further.

Each CallConnect bus operates within a designated service area of up to 12 miles. In each operating area, you'll have access to hundreds of pick up and drop off places. Passengers can travel to their chosen location in villages and towns that are within the service area.

What are the fares?

The fare is specific to your journey. The further you travel, the more the fare.

Children aged between 5-15 pay half the adult fare and children under 5 travel FREE with an accompanying adult. You can also use your concessionary bus pass on CallConnect.

Frequent Travel - Save Money

If you pay for your bus ticket and travel regularly, you may want to consider buying a CallConnect Saver Ticket onboard the bus. For more information, contact the booking centre on 0345 234 33 44 or ask your driver.

Register and book...

You will need to register first to use the service. Registering is FREE and provides you with a personal registration number to make future bookings quick and easy.

You can then book a bus journey from 1 hour up to 7 days in advance.

...then get on board

Head to the bus stop, hop on board, pay the fare and travel!

You can also use your Lincolnshire concessionary bus pass on CallConnect at any time. Through ticketing available on the North of Lincoln service.

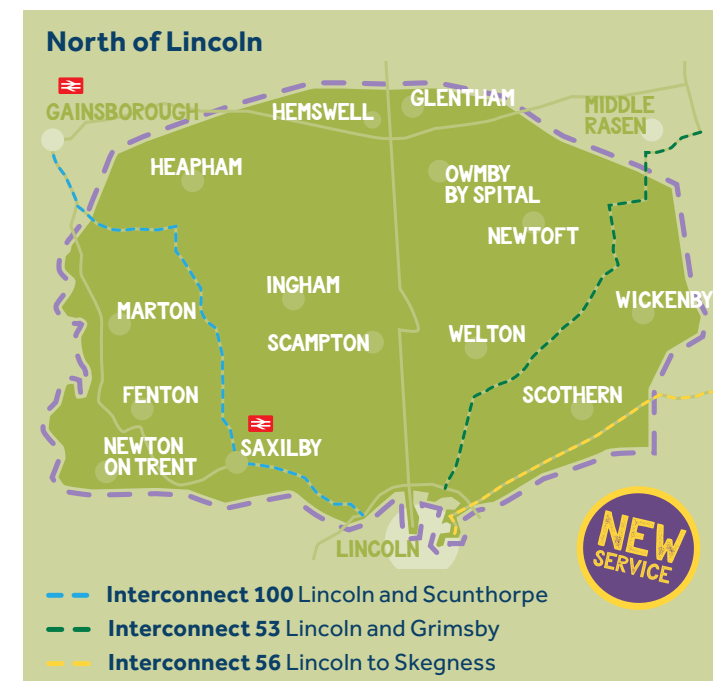
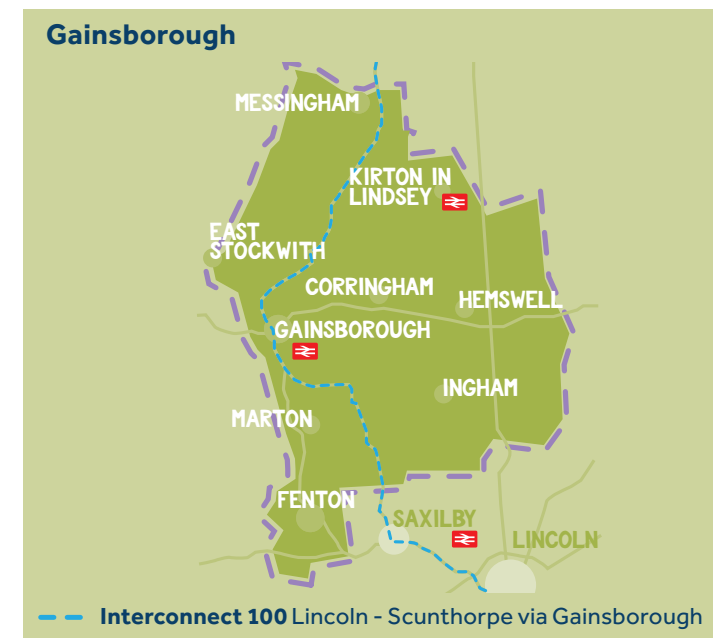
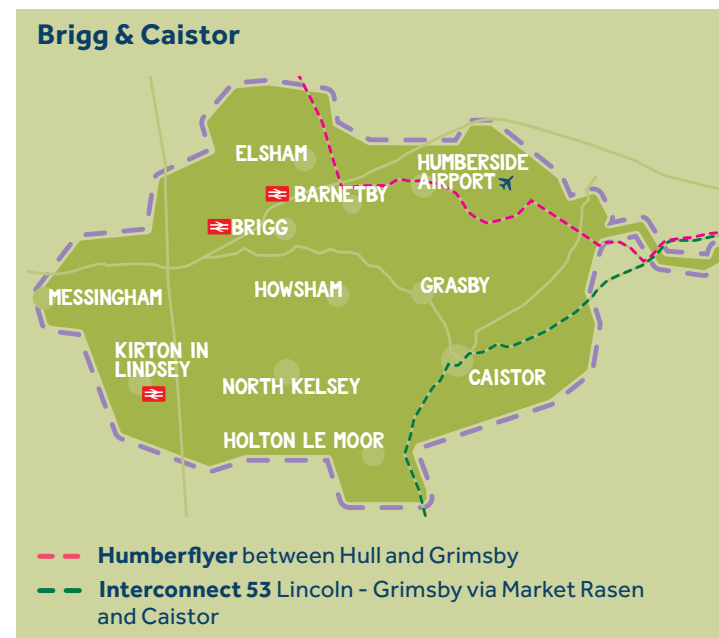

Access Information for North of Lincoln Service

- North of Lincoln CallConnect (100L) serves north of Lincoln area in the West Lindsey district.
- The main connection points are Lincoln Waitrose Park and Ride and Saxilby.
- We also serve Lincoln County Hospital, Tesco on Wragby Road and Newport in Uphill Lincoln.
- Village to village journeys are available within the operating area – connect further afield to access important local services such as doctors surgeries at Welton, Saxilby and Ingham.
- If you wish to travel into Lincoln City Centre, our Booking Team will advise you on your nearest bus or rail connection point. Connections are also available at Saxilby with bus and rail services.
